With almost 200 active cannabis-related bills, tracking legislation can be daunting. Federal

Several Federal bills received new co-sponsors last week:

- HR 1820- Veterans Equal Access Act: John Yarmuth (Dem-KY)
- HR 3530- Industrial Hemp Farming Act: Rodney Davis (Rep-IL), Paul Tonk (Dem-NY)

Florida

In Florida, legislation that would allow judges to break from mandatory minimums has been postponed. [So602](#) was to be heard on the 13th, a new date has not been set.

Also happening in Florida, Republican Representative Matt Gaetz has [filed an amendment to the VA infrastructure bill](#) designed to increase participation by Veterans seeking medical cannabis.

Wisconsin

Wisconsin legislators received the fiscal impact reports for their proposed cannabis legalization bill, [AB 482](#). The Department of Revenue predicts almost \$150million in taxes by 2021. The [full reports and estimates can be found here](#).
