Results of the 2018 Primary Elections:

The following states have legalized Medical Cannabis: **Missouri** ([Amendment 2](#)), **Utah** ([Prop. 2](#)),

The following states have legalized Adult-Use Cannabis: **Michigan** ([Proposal 1](#))

A bill has been introduced in **New York**, [SB 9189](#), relates to providing insurance coverage for medical marijuana users.

[Senate Bill 2275](#) has progressed in **Illinois**, creating marijuana legalization Referendum Act. Requiring the State Board of Elections to cause a statewide question to be submitted on opinions of legalization in the state.

November 12th

A partisan bill in Texas has been introduced, proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize and regulate the possession, cultivation, and sale of cannabis. Read more about [SJR8](#).

- [House Bill 63](#) was also introduced, relating to the civil and criminal penalties for possession of certain small amounts of marijuana and an exception to prosecution for possession. – As well as [SB156](#) .
- [House Bill 122](#) – Provides an affirmative defense to prosecution for possession of marijuana.
- [House Bill 209](#) – Authorizing the possession, use, cultivation, distribution, transportation, and delivery of medical cannabis for medical use for qualifying patients; also for licensing of dispensing organizations and testing facilities.

November 16th

[AB 3506](#), introduced Nov. 7 in **New York**, enacts the “Marihuana regulation and taxation act”; makes technical changes regarding the definition of marihuana; relates to the qualification of certain consumption, display, production or distribution of marijuana.

November 21

Lawmakers in **New Jersey** have introduced and progressed a bill to legalize cannabis in the state. [S2730](#) would legalize possession and personal use of an ounce or less of cannabis by adults.
